### *What do I need to include?*

### *Instructions*

- Re-do your logbook every five years
- When the logbook period begin and ends
- The cars odometer reading at the start and end of the logbook period
- The total number of kilometres that the car travelled during the logbook period
- The number of kilometres travelled for work during the logbook period based on journeys recorded in the logbook. If you make two or more in a row on the same day, they be recorded as a single journey, and
- The business use percentage for the logbook period.
